The April 24, 2023, Special Board Meeting of the Caribe Palm Community Development District (the "District") was called to order at 6:46 p.m. in the Silver Palms Mailbox Kiosk located at 23020 SW 113th Passage, Miami, Florida 33170.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

It was determined that the attendance of Chairperson Madeline Martin, Vice Chairperson Merlin Nicieza and Supervisors Carmen Maseda and Robert Fox constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. March 6, 2023, Regular Board Meeting

The minutes of the March 6, 2023, Regular Board Meeting were presented and the Board was asked if there were any changes. There being no changes, a **motion** was made by Ms. Maseda, seconded by Ms. Nicieza and unanimously passed approving the minutes of the March 6, 2023, Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

G. OLD BUSINESS

1. Update Regarding Main Entrance Project – $FPL\ 2^{nd}$ Phase Replacement and Potential Landscaping Replacement

Mr. Silva stated that FPL is still in the process of replacing the 2nd Phase of the FPL meter located near the entrance of the community and has temporarily restored power to the area. An update regarding this item will be provided at an upcoming meeting.

2. Update Regarding Traffic Control Street Light Request – SW 232nd Street

Mr. Silva informed the Board that FDOT has installed a traffic counter on the South Entrance intersection to measure the amount of vehicular traffic in the area. Once the results are in, FDOT will determine if a traffic control street light is warranted.

3. Update Regarding Installation of LPR Cameras and Upgrades

Mr. Silva presented a proposal from ERSC in the amount of \$3,096 for upgrades to the current District camera system. He also presented the following email from field ops staff:

Good morning Armando, Please see attached the proposal from ERSC in regards to the additional LPRs for Caribe Palm Eddie warned me of the following in regards to the placement. For the lift station, the view would be quite limited to just the cars traveling south along SW 113th place (photo attached of approximate view) For the placement of the LPR at the mailbox, if it were to be placed where the other cameras are, it would be limited to viewing as well only those driving east on SW 230 Passage. However if a pole were to be constructed and placed in the approximate area of IMG 7918. It would be able to read the license of traffic traveling east, north, and south Of course the construction of the pole would be an additional cost but ERSC told me they would be able to do it. Once you have had a chance to review please let me know Thanks,

A discussion ensued after which the Board requested that Mr. Silva obtain a second proposal from a contractor for the updates to the District cameras system.

Mr. Silva stated that Field Ops staff is still waiting on a response from FDOT regarding the results of the traffic study that was conducted on the South Entrance of the District. Mr. Silva also stated that a "Do Not Block" area has been requested on the East Entrance of the community. More information will be provided at an upcoming meeting.
