

CARIBE PALM COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING FEBRUARY 5, 2024

A. CALL TO ORDER

The February 5, 2024, Regular Board Meeting of the Caribe Palm Community Development District (the "District") was called to order at 6:45 p.m. at the Silver Palms Mailbox Kiosk located at 23020 SW 113th Passage, Miami, Florida 33170.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented that notice of the February 5, 2024, Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on December 29, 2023, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

It was determined that the attendance of Chairperson Madeline Martin, Vice Chairperson Merlin Nicieza and Supervisors Carmen Maseda, Hery Morales and Robert Fox constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Staff present: District Manager Armando Silva of Special District Services, Inc.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. January 8, 2024, Special Board Meeting

The minutes of January 8, 2024, Special Board Meeting were presented and the Board was asked if there were any changes. There being no changes, a **motion** was made by Ms. Maseda, seconded by Ms. Nicieza and unanimously passed approving the minutes of the January 8, 2024, Special Board Meeting, as presented.

G. OLD BUSINESS

1. Update Regarding Installation of LPR Cameras and Upgrades

Mr. Silva stated that WAR Protection One, Inc. is still waiting on the arrival of the equipment necessary to commence Phase II of the License Plate Recognition ("LPR") Cameras Installation Project. The next batch of LPR cameras will be located near the mailbox canopy structure.

2. Discussion Regarding Entrance Feature Paint Colors

Mr. Silva provided the following proposals relating to the painting of the entrance feature:

- KB Company Darien Stuart \$2,925
- Building Unlimited \$3,000
- State of the Art Marble \$3,015

The scope of services will entail pressure cleaning the entrance feature; filling any holes in the molding; painting with primer; and two coats of color paint. A discussion ensued after which;

A **motion** was made by Mr. Fox, seconded by Ms. Maseda and unanimously passed to approve the proposal from State of the Art Marble in the amount of \$3015 (State of the Marble is owned by a resident of the community who the Board believes will take care of the work better than others since the contractor has interest in the community).

H. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2024-01 – Electronic Signature Policy

Mr. Silva provided the Board with an overview of the resolution and stated that the resolution provides an electronic signature policy and provides the District Manager with authority and responsibility for approval of electronic signatures and implementation of control processes and procedures to ensure compliance, integrity and security in accordance with Chapter 688, Florida Statutes. A discussion ensued after which;

A **motion** was made by Mr. Morales, seconded by Ms. Nicieza and unanimously passed to approve Resolution No. 2024-01 as presented.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE & OPERATIONAL MATTERS

1. Legislative Memo 2023 – Required Ethics Training

Mr. Silva presented a memorandum which will serve as a reminder that beginning January 1, 2024, elected and appointed commissioners of community redevelopment agencies and local officers of independent special districts are required to complete four (4) hours of ethics training annually. The training must address, at a minimum, s. 8, Art. II of the Florida Constitution (ethics for public officers and financial disclosure), the Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees, and the Florida Public Records Law and Open Meetings laws.

J. BOARD MEMBER & STAFF CLOSING COMMENTS

There were no Board Member or staff closing comments at this time.
