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#### CARIBE PALM COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MARCH 4, 2024

### A. CALL TO ORDER

The March 4, 2024, Regular Board Meeting of the Caribe Palm Community Development District (the "District") was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Silver Palms Mailbox Kiosk located at 23020 SW 113<sup>th</sup> Passage, Miami, Florida 33170.

### **B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION**

Proof of publication was presented that notice of the March 4, 2024, Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Daily Business Review* on September 25, 2023, as legally required.

#### C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

It was determined that the attendance of Chairperson Madeline Martin (via conference call), Vice Chairperson Merlin Nicieza and Supervisors Carmen Maseda and Robert Fox constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Staff present: District Manager Armando Silva of Special District Services, Inc.

Others in attendance: Alexander Gonzalez, Miami, FL.

## D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

#### E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

#### F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES 1. February 5, 2024, Regular Board Meeting

The minutes of the February 6, 2023, Special Board Meeting were presented and the Board was asked if there were any changes. A **motion** was made by Ms. Maseda, seconded by Ms. Nicieza and unanimously passed approving the minutes of the February 5, 2024, Regular Board Meeting, as *amended*; revising the motion for agenda item G.2. to reflect that Ms. Nicieza abstained from voting due to a possible conflict and thus filled out a Form 8B.

#### G. OLD BUSINESS 1. Update Regarding Installation of LPR Cameras and Upgrades

Mr. Silva stated that WAR Protection One, Inc. is still waiting on the arrival of the equipment necessary to commence Phase II of the License Plate Recognition ("LPR") Cameras Installation Project. The next batch of LPR cameras will be located near the mailbox canopy structure.

# 2. Discussion Regarding Entrance Feature - Painting and HOA Request for Additional Lighting

Mr. Silva stated that the contractor working on the painting project for the entrance feature (State of the Art Marble) informed him that the keystone around the entrance feature has several cracks that need to be repaired and the steel letters are corroded. A proposal for the keystone repairs and restoration of the letters was presented in the amount of \$4,250. A discussion ensued after which the board requested that the current work be paused until District Management was able to reach out to the contractors who originally provided a quote so that they could also provide a quote for the additional work.

Mr. Silva also informed the Board that Property Manager Vidhaly Verges had reached out to him on behalf of the Silver Palms Homeowners Association stating that there is a lack of lighting in the front entrance of the community. A discussion ensued after which the board requested that Mr. Silva provide a proposal to install flood lamps in the front entrance feature.

### H. NEW BUSINESS

#### 1. Consider Resolution No. 2024-02 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2024/2024 Proposed Budget

Mr. Silva presented Resolution No. 2024-02, entitled:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-02**

#### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CARIBE PALM COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Silva read the title of the resolution into the record and reviewed the proposed budget. He advised that since the overall proposed assessments were not increasing in the fiscal year 2024/2025, letters to residents would not be required. Furthermore, Mr. Silva stated as part of Resolution No. 2024-02, the Board must set a date for the public hearing to adopt the 2023/2024 final fiscal year budget and assessments. A discussion ensued after which:

A **motion** was made by Ms. Maseda, seconded by Ms. Nicieza and unanimously passed approving and adopting Resolution No. 2024-02, *as presented*, and thus setting the public hearing to adopt the 2024/2025 Fiscal Year budget and assessments for <u>May 6, 2024, at 6:45 p.m.</u> at the Silver Palms Mailbox Kiosk located at 23020 SW 113<sup>th</sup> Passage, Miami, Florida 33170.

### I. ADMINISTRATIVE & OPERATIONAL MATTERS

### 1. Ethics Training Memo – SDS, Inc.

Mr. Silva presented a memorandum from SDS, Inc. which will serve as a reminder that beginning January 1, 2024, elected and appointed commissioners of community redevelopment agencies and local officers of independent special districts are required to complete four (4) hours of ethics training annually. The training must address, at a minimum, s. 8, Art. II of the Florida Constitution (ethics for public officers and financial disclosure), the Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees, and the Florida Public Records Law and Open Meetings laws.

There were no Board Member or Staff closing comments.
