A. CALL TO ORDER

The November 4, 2024, Regular Board Meeting of the Caribe Palm Community Development District (the "District") was called to order at 6:55 p.m.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented that notice of the November 4, 2024, Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Miami Herald* on September 20, 2024, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

It was determined that the attendance of Chairperson Madeline Martin, Vice Chairperson Merlin Nicieza and Supervisors Carmen Maseda, Hery Morales and Robert Fox constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.
